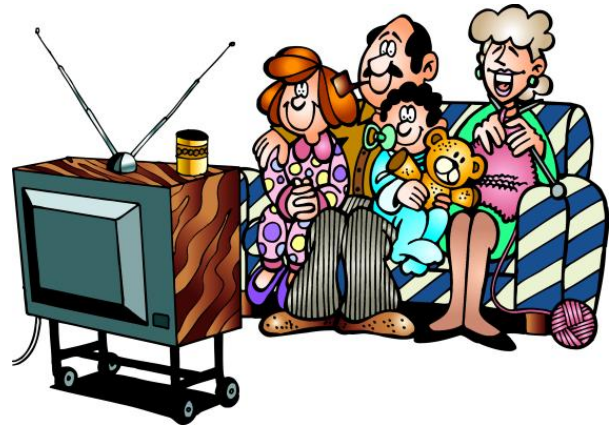


Types of TV Programmes
